IITBBS holds medical camp

Bhubaneswar: The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhubaneswar, in collaboration with KIMS Hospital, organized a medical camp for its students at the community centre on its campus on Saturday.

A total of 247 students participated in the health camp. They were checked by a team of medicine specialists, gynaecologists, a physiotherapist, an ophthalmologist and a dental surgeon from the hospital. A series of tests such as blood sugar and ECG, among others, were conducted.

IIT Bhubaneswar director RV Raja Kumar said students often neglected their health owing to their hectic study schedules and limited time. "We organized a health camp in the interests of the student community. We believe that this programme is a timely preventive health check-up mechanism and can help minimize health hazards among students," Kumar added. **TNN**
