

Health Camp by UBA IIT Bhubaneswar on November 12, 2022



During the visit, the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) team of IIT Bhubaneswar had learnt that villagers need to reach far for medical facilities since Kansapada does not have one. Therefore, a free medical health checkup camp was conducted by the UBA team (Health and Sanitation) of IIT Bhubaneswar on 12th of November, 2022 at the Government High School of Kansapada village. The camp started at 10:30 am with the members of the medical team from the Medical Unit of IIT Bhubaneswar with the UBA team. Medical officers Dr. S.P. Mishra and Dr. Manu Mohan along with pharmacist Mr. Srinibash Panigrahi and the staff nurse Ms. Rajalaxmi Mishra attended a total of 160 villagers in the camp. General checkups were conducted with measuring blood pressure and blood sugar. Besides, medicines were dispensed at free of cost after the check-ups. Patients who needed further treatment were referred to the higher centers. Villagers including children, women and elderly persons were greatly benefitted throughout the day. The camp was successfully organized by 20 volunteers (students of IIT Bhubaneswar) led by Health and Sanitation Theme Leader Dr. Anasuya Roychowdhury and UBA Coordinator Dr. Seema Bahinipati.
